

St Giles', Oxford: Records in 1850 Notebook: Payments received by the ringers, etc

NOTES AND COMMENTS

In the original, years are often shown at the top of the page, sometimes centred; month and day dates in a left hand column; other details in a main central column; I haven't attempted to reproduce this layout, though I have approximately copied the way the original showed amounts of money received, at the right (in £ s and d). There are often horizontal lines ruled across the page between entries, but I have only copied what seemed the more important of these.

Abbreviations are copied as written (i.e. not expanded when transcribed); trailing letters e.g. 't' in St Giles, 'r' in Mr, 'r' in Nov.r, and 'st' in 1st, are in the original usually written smaller and above the line (except in the very latest years), and in the earlier years I have represented this by putting a full stop between the abbreviated start of the word and any such trailing letters.

Names whose spelling was particularly uncertain have been copied in < >. Comments added by myself are in []. The first entry of each year date has been transcribed in large bold figures, as a finding aid, whether or not it was written prominently in the notebook.

Especially in the earlier years, ringing seems to have taken place and been paid for to celebrate elections or appointments to various positions, and the persons concerned have in most cases signed their own names in the notebook (often not very legibly). The payments listed against their names (almost always 6 / 0) should therefore probably be assumed to have been made by the persons named (i.e. not by the parish), and so the entry could have been regarded as a receipt. Perhaps such people had some freedom to choose whether and where to have bells rung; probably no ringing would have taken place unless it had been specifically requested, and with the expectation that payments would be made to the St Giles ringers ?

For Town/City Council elections, only one or two names appear each year: probably they were the Aldermen or Councillors elected specifically for North Ward, and perhaps they were having St Giles' bells rung primarily because it was the most central and/or oldest church in the area - and the only one with bells - rather than because they themselves were regular worshippers at the church. The last payments for ringing celebrating election to civic offices were for the election of Thos Lucas as Sheriff in 1890, and then as Mayor in 1892.

Payments for ringing to mark the election of churchwardens, at Eastertime every year, continued much longer. More often than not, churchwardens served for several years, but nevertheless their re-election was still rung for every year. The amount paid per person was increased from 6 shillings to 8 shillings in 1928, and such ringing and payments continued until 1935.

It is notable that, up to 1907, amounts paid in the same year for ringing for Marriages vary. Were the amounts paid a reflection of the parties' social standing, or ability to pay - if so, who decided on the amount? Or of their standing in relationship to the parish - whether or not resident or on the electoral roll ? From 1908 onward, the payment was a uniform £1/1/0 (1 guinea); which increased to £1/8/0 in 1927, to £2/0/0 in 1946, and to £4/0/0 in 1970 or 1971.

Payments for weddings included two, in 1911 and in 1949, for weddings at the R C church of St Aloysius (across Woodstock Rd – later known as the Oratory); and one in 1971 for a wedding shortly to take place in Canberra, Australia.

The numbers of weddings for which bells were rung and paid for fluctuated considerably from year to year: perhaps there were times when the ringers couldn't provide a band, or perhaps there was a tendency for families in the parish to copy each other in either having or not having the bells rung. Probably there were many other weddings which took place at St Giles without having the bells rung, and which are therefore not recorded in this notebook.

Up to 1935, the names of bridegrooms and brides were almost always entered with the titles of Mr and Miss (Christian names often omitted). There was no case of a bride recorded as Mrs, even in war-time – perhaps it was felt that having bells rung would be inappropriate for the remarriage of a widow? There were a surprising number of bridegrooms who had the title Rev, but who were not described as Vicar or curates in St Giles' parish; may this somehow be because they had previously undertaken degree studies or ordination training in Oxford? From 1958 onwards, the person making the entries in most cases recorded the ages of the groom and bride – the first example was for the marriage of a man aged 40 to a woman aged 36, which was perhaps felt to be noteworthy.

There are few entries indicating payment for ringing for a funeral; but there are some entries in the early years just showing the name of a person, without explaining the reason for ringing: possibly an abbreviated record of ringing for a wedding, or ringing requested to celebrate a major birthday or other personal event – but quite probably these could have been funerals.

Receipt of a 'Salary', '1/2 Years Salary', or 'Quarter's Salary', and of payment for '5 (or 4) Customary Ringing Days', is recorded in many years, though not all. Payments of 'Salary', of Hendy's Bequest, and for Customary Ringing Days were resumed in 1901, and then continued until 1958. Hendy's Bequest payment had been 5 shillings for many years, but was reduced to 4 shillings in 1935: a note, referring to an enclosed letter, indicates that this change was made on the authority of the Church Commissioners.

The annual 'Customary Ringing Days' are not identified anywhere in the book; the number recorded as covered by the annual payment was reduced from 5 to 4 in 1903, but without any comment or explanation.

Presumably all the payments recorded were expected to be shared out (equally?) among the ringers, but there is no record of how or when any of the money received was disposed of. In years where there is no record of such payments received, did this mean that the band was at a low ebb, and didn't do the ringing expected, and therefore payment wasn't claimed (or was refused) -- or possibly the payments may have been made, but were not recorded.
